Classic Cooking



Ingredients:

- 4 red potatoes / new potatoes
- 2 tablespoons chopped fresh dill
- 2 hardboiled eggs, chopped
- ¼ cup diced red onion
- ½ cup sour cream
- ¼ cup mayo

Directions: Boil potatoes, skins on, until tender. When done, quarter and spread into a pyrex dish, and liberally sprinkle with kosher salt, pepper, and white wine vinegar. Let those cool. Meanwhile, chop dill, eggs, and onion. In another bowl make the sauce. Add mayo, sour cream, and white wine vinegar and stir. You want to achieve a pourable consistency, and you may need to add more vinegar or sour cream depending on your taste. Lightly combine all ingredients in a bowl, careful not to break up the potatoes too much. Season with additional salt and pepper, and serve!
