#### Classic Cooking

#### Ingredients:

1(14-oz.) can sweetened condensed milk 1 tablespoon loosely packed lemon zest

 $^{1\!\!/_{\!\!2}}$  cup key lime juice

 $3~{
m large~egg~yolks}$ 

¼ cup buttermilk

Ready-made graham cracker crust

Vegetable cooking spray Sweetened Whipped Cream

Key Lime-Buttermilk Icebox Pie

#### Directions:

- Preheat oven to 325°. Whisk together first 3 ingredients in a bowl.
- •Beat egg yolks with a handheld mixer in a medium bowl at high speed 4 to 5 minutes or until yolks become pale and ribbons form on surface of mixture when beater is lifted. Gradually whisk in sweetened condensed milk mixture, and whisk until thoroughly combined; whisk in buttermilk. Pour mixture into crust.
- Bake at 325° for 20 to 25 minutes or until set around edges. (*Pie will be slightly jiggly*.) Cool on a wire rack 1 hour. Cover pie with lightly greased (*with cooking spray*) plastic wrap, and freeze 4 to 6 hours.
- •Top with Sweetened Whipped Cream.
